Hello Jo-Anne,

Great seeing you today after such a long time and thank you for our meeting and discussion. We were discussing the formation of a radio controlled flying club and future sanctioned by the Model Aeronautics Association of Canada (MAAC).v During the meeting:

- We reviewed MAC magazine with some of the aircraft our members fly
- I gave you a copy of the MAAC document list found on our website regarding our safety guidelines, rules and policies.
- We looked at the proposed flying site map and the airport proximity map showing distance from our flying site location to the airport. You have copies of the club application and other documentation regarding the site.
- Per MAAC club rules and insurance, only Members are allowed to fly at the site who must abide by all MAAC and club safety rules, policies and procedures.
- Per Town of Deseronto motion, flights are limited to between 8 am and 8 pm
- Flight at the club would normally be on weekends but flights during the week, weather permitting, are also expected
- Base leg on approach to runway 27 has normal altitude decrease from 1000' to 500' AGL. Base leg normally is turned well west of Deseronto but can approach the western limit on long downwind but still well west of flying site.
- For all flights below 300' AGL, a phone call to your cell number as provided will be made at the start of flying session and at termination.
- For flights greater than 300' AGL or weekend events, the club will have NOTAM issued.

I trust this covers everything we discussed of importance and I thank you again for meeting with me and quickly dealing with these issues, allowing our club to proceed.

You, your staff and students are welcome at any time to join us. We have provisions to set up "buddy boxes" if you're interested in trying some small scale aviation from a different perspective.
