

FOREST LAKESIDE FLYERS FIELD RULES

1. M.A.A.C. membership is required to fly.
2. Members must adhere to all M.A.A.C. rules.
3. There shall be no flying over the pit area or the parking area.
4. There shall be no flying while the grass is being cut.
5. Pilots using 2.4 Gigahertz frequency radios have the freedom to fly when they want to, using common sense to space themselves out to limit the number of aircraft in the air to more than 4 – 6 at a time.
Pilots using the old 7.2 transmitters will be self-controlling of their frequencies.
6. Pilots will notify other flyers of taking off, landing and also before going out to retrieve of their aircraft out on the flying field.
7. Everyone is responsible for taking all of their own garbage home.
8. The last member leaving the field shall ensure that the shed is locked and cable is put up across the end of the laneway.
