Southwest Zone / Chatham Kent Municipal Airport Rules

- 1. The Air Marshall / Event Director must have at all times a written letter of approval from the Chatham Kent Township and Model Aeronautics Association of Canada (MAAC) member card.
- 2. Flying members must carry MAAC member cards at all times.
- 3. Must be a current paid member and in good standing of MAAC and follow MAAC safety code.
- 4. Turbine flyers must adhere to MAAC's turbine safety code.
- 5. Frequency selection must be verified by each RC pilot prior to operating RC aircraft.
- 6. All aircraft must have safety restraints when starting and running up aircraft (brakes are allowed a spotter is preferred)
- 7. Aircraft transceiver radio must be used at all times to monitor incoming and outgoing air traffic (this is monitored and supplied by the Air Marshall or flight line coordinators)
- **8.** All RC aircraft must yield to full size aircraft at all times.
- 9. A spotter must be used at all times.
- 10. No pulse jets or rocket engines are permitted.
- 11. All new aircraft must be deemed airworthy by MAAC certified instructors.
- 12. All flights must be parallel to the runway and south of the centerline, flying behind the runway is not permitted
- 13. There is a total alcohol ban at this airport, anyone under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be asked to leave immediately.
- 14. Any damage caused that is not coved by MAAC is the responsibility of the Pilot and any other responsible party.
- 15. Damage to the runway lights is the responsibility of the pilot.
