

FIELD RULES

- 1. Pilots must have current MAAC Membership. No MAAC NO FLYING.
- 2. Adherence to MAAC Rules is mandatory.
- 72MHz systems pin must be on the board before switching on. If you shoot down another plane, you buy it!
- 4. Gas & Glow powered planes must be restrained when starting. Run up engines outside the pits; preferably start outside pits.
- 5. No taxiing in the pits.
- 6. Electric planes: Connect batteries only immediately before flight and disconnected immediately after flight; do not rely on ESC to disarm motor.
- Noise rule: Full throttle, 99dB(A) at 9 feet MAX. Pilots must make their aircraft available for testing if asked. Applies to electrics too.
- 8. When more than one aircraft is airborne, pilots shall fly the same runway circuit. Helicopters and DLGs may operate at the far end of the non-active runway.
- Only Park Flyer models may be flown before 08:00AM or after 9:30PM.
- 10. Members may host guest pilots twice per season (each guest). Membership is required from the third visit on. Club sponsored events do not count towards guest's two visit max.
- 11. Do not fly over the pilot stations, pits or parking area. Two infractions ends your day's flying.
- 12. Minimize flight time & noise in NE quadrant.
- 13. Keep the field clean pack out your trash & empty fuel containers.
- 14. Fire extinguisher required for Gas & Turbines.
- 15. No alcohol unless you're finished flying for the day. No alcohol in pits at any time.
