## Rycroft Wings & Blades, MAAC RC Club # 781 Rules

- To fly at the club flying site the pilot must have a current MAAC membership. Visiting fliers will be required to present their MAAC card and be accompanied by a current club member.
- 2. Each pilot must carry his/her MAAC card with them while flying. Spot checks may be expected from regulating bodies.
- 3. All flying must be done in accordance with the most CURRENT MAAC Safety code and MAAC Policies, Procedures and documents. More details can be seen at the following website: <a href="http://www.maac.ca/en/documents.php">http://www.maac.ca/en/documents.php</a>. All flying must be done in accordance with the guidelines set out in these documents.
- 4. Each aircraft must have at least one external label clearly identifying the MAAC web site <a href="www.maac.ca">www.maac.ca</a>, the owners MAAC number, name, and telephone number of the owner.
- 5. All radio control flying must be done north of the pilot's stations. There is no flying allowed south of the flight line unless field is being used for control line flying. When control line flying is active, the south side of the safety fence becomes the pit area and all R/C flying must be stopped.
- 6. The Rycroft Wings & Blades does not permit the use of 72mhz radios, this is a 2.4 site only as we no longer run a frequency board. Please park in designated parking area after unloading aircraft at the field.
- 7. There are start-up stations for large and small aircraft located in the club house. These must be used when starting fueled aircraft.
