
and the Ausable Bayfield Conservation Authority and involving the following facilities and dates:
Parkhill Conservation Area north reservoir access, Parkhill Reservoir (as defined on map)
May 1, 2023 - October 31, 2023.

This agreement is subject to the following conditions.


The person or party entering into this agreement with the Ausable Bayfield Conservation Authority:

- (a) will adhere to all Conservation Authority rules and regulations including those for Conservation Areas except as exempted by this agreement;
- (b) will adhere to all legislation, regulations and etiquette pertaining to the use of radio control model aircraft;
- (c) will post appropriate signage to advise other visitors of the use of the area;
- (d) will leave the conservation area in proper order and accepts responsibility for damages or loss of property as a result of their use;
- (e) will not damage or remove any tree, plant or wildlife;
- (f) will not erect any structures with the exception of non-permanent shade pavilions which will only be in place when the club member is at the site;
- (g) accepts responsibility for the safety of any person associated with the above-mentioned party and agrees not to hold the Ausable Bayfield Conservation Authority responsible in the event of an accident or injury;
- (h) The CLUB shall provide to the Ausable Bayfield Conservation Authority a Certificate of Insurance showing the extent of coverage and limits of liability are maintained for the duration of this agreement. The insurance shall include Comprehensive General Liability with limits of at least Five Million Dollars (\$5,000,000) per occurrence for bodily injury, death and damage to property. The Certificate of Insurance shall stipulate the Authority has been made an additional insured under this policy with respect to all operations or services performed under this agreement. The insurance in (a) and (b) above shall be primary and not entitled to contribution from any insurance maintained by the Authority. These certificates shall be on file with the ABCA before commencement of the agreement.
- (i) Notwithstanding the dates of the agreement, the ABCA cannot guarantee water levels in the reservoir will be suitable for the activities. This is a flood control structure and water

levels will be maintained for the purposes of flood control. This includes flooding events and lowering water levels for annual maintenance. After September 1, access to the site may be restricted and the water level may not be suitable for flying activities.
