

HCRCC SAFETY RULES

1. Strict adherence to the MAAC safety code. See MAAC Safety Codes for a list of MAAC regulations. (*Website location: MAAC.CA, Resources, Documents, Advisory Group-Safety, MAAC Safety Code.*)
2. Strict adherence to the flying regulations as outlined in the Wings program.
3. No flying under the influence of alcohol or drugs, while mentally or physically impaired, including under the influence of intoxicants or medications.
4. Flying must be done from inside the Pilot Stations. This means take-offs and landings too. Exception for hand-launching; you should launch at the Flight-Line, then return to the Pilot Station.
5. All flyers must have a valid MAAC membership and be a HCRCC member in good standing, or the guest of a member in good standing.
6. Only members in good standing and their guests are welcome to use the field and facilities.
7. All take-offs and landings must be on the runway, parallel to the Flightline, and in the designated direction.
8. Call your take-offs and landings. Inform other fliers when crossing the field.
9. Dead sticks have landing priority.
10. Do not loiter on the runway. All maintenance must be done off the runway.
11. Maximum 10 in the air at the same time.
12. Pilots must fly in front of the flight line at all times.
13. No flying over or behind the pit area.
14. No take-offs permitted from the pit area.
15. Taxiing **OUT** is permitted from the Start Up Area to the runway. Taxiing **IN** from the Flight-line must end at the front side of the Pilot Stations.

16. In the pit area all aircraft must point towards the runway.
17. For those not using a spread spectrum transmitter, the frequency board must be used, and proper procedures observed.
 - a. proper frequency pins must be used.
 - b. remove only your own pin.
 - c. only narrow-band and spread-spectrum radios allowed.
18. People using flammable fuel must be in reasonable proximity to a fire extinguisher (HCRCC fire extinguishers in the startup area). Turbine operators shall have an effective, operational Carbon Dioxide or other suitable fire extinguisher (not powder) within reach during all turbine operations.
19. Mufflers required on all engines of .19 cubic inches and over (unless designated otherwise for predetermined occasions and approved by the membership at a regular club meeting).
20. No willful damage to the club flying site and facilities.
21. No unsportsmanlike conduct.
22. Vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas.
23. No unsupervised children allowed in the pit area or on the flight line.
24. No pets allowed in the pit area or on the runway. All pets must be on a leash.
25. Each member is responsible for their refuse - take it home.
26. No fires in other than the designated areas.
27. R/C ground vehicles are allowed to operate out past the flightline when NO aircraft are in operation, with an exception for special events with verbal consent given from all current active pilots.

Violation of any of the above rules may result in your HCRCC membership being revoked.
