SKYSEEKERS RC CLUB RULES

- 1) All fliers at the SkySeekers RC Club airfield <u>will follow and enforce</u> all safety rules as set out by the <u>MAAC Safety Code</u>.
- All fliers at the SkySeeker RC Club airfield must be a current member of MAAC, and be able to provide proof to any executive of same at any time while at the field.
- 3) There shall be a limit of 2 fliers permitted to fly at one time without spotters.
- 4) Spotters will be required for ALL fliers numbering 3, to a limit of 4, at any one time.
- 5) All flying activity must be halted should a member need the use of a vehicle within the flying zone to retrieve a downed aircraft.
- 6) Night flying is permitted however, pilots must have the aid of one (1)spotter during any night flight.
- 7) Upon spotting of a full scale aircraft, pilots will immediately lower altitude and land as quickly as possible. Once aircraft is deemed to have left the flying area, flying operations may once again commence.
- 8) Flying area will stay within 1750' left and right of pilot station and will stay within the red boundaries as shown on flying site area map as attached to this document of rules.

A copy of these rules shall be kept with the minutes of the Club, and updated as found necessary by either MAAC or the membership. Additions or deletions of rules must be approved by majority of the membership. All members will receive a copy of the above rules of the Club. A copy of the MAAC "<u>Procedures after an Incident</u>" shall be attached to the SkySeeker RC Club Rules, and a copy given to all members to review.
