

## Kawartha Lakes RC Flyers Code of Conduct

Adopted May 11, 2004 Updated November 8, 2019

### Code of Conduct

This code is intended to outline those matters that are expected of all modellers as common courtesy and for everyone's safety.

1. I will abide by the "MAAC Safety Code," the "MAAC Etiquette and Safe Operations Code," and the "MAAC Safety Code for R/C Field Operation."
2. I will always conduct myself in a polite and responsible manner.
3. I will respect the safety of myself and others without being reminded of the need to do so and will be conscious that the maintenance of safety for others and myself rests with my ability to design, construct, and operate sound working models.
4. I will not fly fuel powered models at the club field before 9:00 am.
5. I will not fly if there are currently 4 aircraft in the air.
6. I will loudly announce to other pilots my intention to take off, land, or move onto or off the runway. When another pilot makes an announcement of his intention, I will clearly acknowledge his announcement.
7. I will not move onto the runway except for the placement and retrieval of aircraft, and only then with the agreement of the other pilots. I will be prompt.
8. When any person is on the runway, I will maintain my aircraft at a safe altitude until the runway is clear.
9. If I am a beginner, I recognize that I must be assisted by a qualified club pilot while flying at any club flying site, until I have obtained my "Wings", and that my aircraft must be inspected prior to its first flight, and after any significant repair.
10. I should make every effort to ensure that the operation of my model does not interfere with the enjoyment of the hobby by others.
11. I expect to retain full control over my visitors or guests, particularly children and pets. It should not be necessary for other club members to substitute as host or attempt to apply club codes to guests.
12. I recognise that I share the sky with other modellers and will be considerate by attention to where and how I operate my models.
13. My aircraft should be inspected by another experienced modeler prior to its first flight, and after any significant repair.
14. Before retrieving a downed aircraft from private property, I will ask for the owner's permission. I will be courteous to our neighbours.
15. I will attach an Owner Contact Information label to my models in accordance with MAAC MPPD 10.
16. I will not use model rockets at any club flying site.
17. I will not loan out equipment belonging to the Kawartha Lakes Flyers.
