ELK POINT RC CLUB FLYING FIELD RULES

1) All flyers must have a current MAAC membership. Club Members will be checked upon renewal. Visitors must present their current MAAC memberhip card

2) All pilots must carry their current MAAC card with them while flying. Either the digital or hard copy cards are acceptable.

3) All flying must be done in accordance with the most current MAAC SAFETY CODE and MAAC Policies and Procedures documents. Each pilot is responsible to keep themselves informed of the most current requirement of these documents. For complete details, please visit: http://www.maac.ca/en/documents.php

4) Club safety rules apply to pilots, their guests and spectators. Children and dogs must be under control, and kept well away from model aircraft.

5) Each aircraft or RPAS must display at least one label clearly identifying

-the owners name

-the owners MAAC number

- the owners phone number

6) Pilots and students must be familiar and adhere to category-specific, type specific, or location specific safety codes contained in the club rules, and in the MAAC Safety Documents and supporting document requirements

7) Pilots must conduct a thorough preflight of their models -including a range check- at the beginning of each flying day.

8) Pilots shall not operate a model aircraft in a reckless or negligent manner as to endanger, or likely to endanger full scale aviation safety, or the safety of any person.

9) Model aircraft or RPAS may not be flown less than 30m laterally (at any altitude) from uninvolved people, vehicles, or structures.

10) Pilots or their spotters shall have the model of RPAS in visual line of sight at all times during flight

11) Pit Rules

-the fenced pit area is for pilots only, however visitors may be permitted upon invitation by a club member. The club member is responsible for the conduct of their guests.

-unsupervised children and spectators are not permitted in the

pit area. The bleachers or the tower provide excellent viewing opportunities.

In the event of an emergency, fire extinguishers are located at the start up area as well and at the far end of the pit by the black equipment cabinet. First Aid kits are located in the equipment cabinet, and in the clubhouse.
