

GRCC Safety Rules:

While most of these rules are common sense rules, please review the full safety document on the M.A.A.C. site.



- 1) Pilots to remain 7 meters back from flight line while flying.
- 2) Club members only allowed in the pit area.
- 3) While starting aircraft, please use a restraint to prevent accidental aircraft movement.
- 4) Please announce intentions when either landing or taking off.
- 5) Members are not allowed on the field (South of flight line) without announcing their intention while aircraft are in the air.
- 6) While flying, all pilots are to respect the flight line. Take offs and landings, both vertical and horizontal, must be accomplished on the south side of the flight line (Please note the position of the flight line when approaching from the North or West corners of the field).
- 7) Landing while directly approaching the pit/spectator area is strictly forbidden (SE approach).
- 8) Frequency control for 72 mhz radios to be monitored to avoid possible interference (Frequency pin to be placed on frequency board during radio operation).
- 9) Flyers must not overfly the 10th line road, located to the east of the field, or over past the hill on the NW side of the field (between the field and 10 sideroad).
