This site is in Toronto Lester B Pearson Class C controlled airspace, all RPAS operation, including mRPAS are prohibited at this MAAC site.

This site is an area readily accessible to by-standers. Per MAAC policy, the club rules should adopt a physical barrier(s) or high visibility markings warning by-standers of the operation (such as gate/fence/rope/surveyors' tape or other visible perimeter markers), or

The site should employ a spotter or system to alert the operator(s) of bystanders who come within the MAAC specified buffer distance from the outer edge of the flying area/circle, or a combination of both.

Any changes to club rules or procedures upon which this authorization was issued must be sent to MAAC.

This authorization is valid until the BALSA BEAVERS MFC INC [Club 115, Zone L] fails to renew their MAAC membership, dissolves, or otherwise does not comply with any MAAC requirements or requests.
