Normal operating procedures and Site safety rules

This site is for meetings only. Static displays of airplane models are allowed, but no batteries will be on site.

1. Models are only allowed as static displays, and if a model is present, the model shall be rendered inoperable.
2. Models on display will be unpowered, no batteries will be allowed on site.
3. All power systems (gas, glow, electric) must be rendered inoperable. Any complete aircraft must have the propeller(s) removed and have all fuel removed from the tanks. Propulsion batteries must be disconnected.
4. A suitable fire extinguisher must be available if models are displayed.

Emergency or safety procedures

1. No other action than contacting 911 for help is necessary.
2. Call 911, advise the person in charge for the Centre Père Arthur Guertin. The nearest exit is about 10 meters from the meeting room. Centre Père Arthur Guertin has everything to answer any emergency situation. (fire extinguishers etc.)
3. There are no other risk mitigating strategies required at this site.
