### Normal operating procedures and Site safety rules

This site is for meetings only. Static displays of airplane models are allowed. No models will be operated.

- 1. Models are only allowed as static displays, and if a model is present, the model shall be rendered inoperable.
- 2. Models on display will be unpowered.

- 3. All power systems (gas, glow, electric) must be rendered inoperable. Any complete aircraft must have the propeller(s) removed and have all fuel removed from the tanks. Propulsion batteries must be disconnected.
- 4. A suitable fire extinguisher must be available if models are displayed.

## **Emergency or safety procedures:**

- 1. Site emergency procedures: Call 911 if needed.
- 2. There are no other risk mitigating strategies required at the MAAC Zone E AZM 2024 meeting site.
- 3. The Club/site/Event organizer/executive will review these rules at least once a year.
