Date: As scheduled annually

Conditions for use - All persons using this modelling site/participating in this event must:

1. be MAAC members in good standing.
2. be members in good standing of the SCPB, or an invited guest of the SCPB, and
3. agree to follow the MAAC Safety code and all other site rules.

A copy of these rules must be present during the mall display, either in print or electronically (on a phone/device). These rules will be posted at the site and linked in the website www.suncitypropbusters.com.

In case of emergency, call 911, and the address to be provided to first responders is:

Normal operating procedures and site safety rules:

This site allows the following modeling categories for display:

- Fixed wing, Quad Copter, 1/10th scale racing vehicles, Scale watercraft

- 1 There is no flying permitted at this site. The Club will only permit the static displays of inoperable model airplanes.
- 2 All power systems (gas, glow or electric) must be rendered inoperable by removing batteries, ignition leads or otherwise ensuring the model cannot inflict harm to any persons.
- 3 All fuel is to be removed from any fuel powered models.
- 4 Charging of lithium batteries is not allowed at the static display. Batteries are not to be connected to the model.
- 5 All models to be displayed in such a way as to not interfere with emergency exiting of the building/site, models ideally be placed on display tables.
- 6 Those models placed on the floor to be behind a cordoned off area and backed up against a wall.
- 7 Flight Simulator equipment including computer, laptop and TV to be placed on solid surfaces. Chairs to be sturdy.
- 8 Demonstration of flight controls, lights, retracts is permitted. Actual flight of craft is not permitted.
- 9 Display of building, construction, completion of a model or a portion of a model is permitted provided that no model equipment is run, example propeller. Razor knives are not permitted to be used when crafting on site.
- 10 Spills on the floor to be cleaned immediately.
- 11 No loose extension cords across travel paths.

Emergency or safety procedures

- 12 A fire extinguisher is provided by the facility, the location to be verified by the club Executive, however, SCPB is responsible to provide their First Aid Kit A small first aid kit must be available while models are displayed.
- 13 Site emergency procedures.
 - a. **In case of emergency, call 911** and advise the President and Vice President as listed above. They in turn will contact the facility manager. Use the facility's emergency exit strategies.

- b. Facility emergency procedures such as phone numbers, exit locations, emergency equipment location (defibrillator, fire extinguishers etc.) and other emergency services as deemed appropriate to be verified with the facility manager.

14 There are no other risk mitigating strategies required at the Estevan Market Square provided site.

15 The Club/site/Event organizer/executive will review and approve these rules prior to each event.
