Conditions for use - All persons using this modelling site must:

- 1. be MAAC members in good standing.
- 2. be members of the Aurora Model Aircraft Club or an invited guest of Aurora Model Aircraft Club, and
- 3. agree to follow the MAAC Safety code and all other site rules.

A copy of these rules must be present during the swap meet, either in print or electronically (on a phone/device). The rules or requirements can be found at the sign in table.

Normal operating procedures and Site safety rule

1. No Electric Motor or Internal Combustion engine may be powered on or otherwise operated at the swap meet.

- 2. All power systems (gas, glow or electric) must be rendered inoperable by removing batteries, ignition leads or otherwise ensuring the model cannot inflict harm to any persons.
- 3. All fuel must be drained from internal combustion powered models.
- 4. A small first aid kit must be available.
- 5. A suitable fire extinguisher must be present.

Emergency or safety procedures

- 1. If anything happens at the hall that is deemed unsafe, Club Representatives or the Event Director, James Bridge, may take any action deem necessary to restore safety, including calling emergency services at 911.
- 2. In the event of an emergency call 911. The civic address for first responder is; 200 Doug Duncan Drive, Newmarket, ON L3Y 3Y9
- 3. If there is an emergency and evacuation is required, patrons will have access to two additional emergency doors at the rear to exit the hall. These doors will be kept unlocked during the event.
- 4. There are no other risk mitigating strategies required at Aurora Model Aircraft Club Event Site.
- 5. The Club executive will review these rules annually and prior to any additional swap meet
