Purpose:

Static Display Only to help raise awareness to the hobby of RC Flying as well as the Moose Jaw Radio Control Club Inc

Date and time: As scheduled from time to time.

Conditions for use - All persons displaying models at this event must:

1. be MAAC members in good standing,
2. be members of the Moose Jaw Radio Control Club Inc or invited guests, and
3. agree to follow the MAAC Safety code and all other site rules.

A copy of these rules must be present during the mall display, either in print or electronically (on a phone/device).

In the event of an emergency, phone 911 and the civic address for first responders is:

Normal operating procedures and Site safety rules:

- 1 There is no flying permitted at this site. The Club will only permit the static displays of inoperable model airplanes.
- 2 All power systems (gas, glow or electric) must be rendered inoperable by removing batteries, ignition leads or otherwise ensuring the model cannot inflict harm to any persons.
- 3 All fuel is to be removed from any fuel powered models.

Moose Jaw Radio Control Club Static Display Rules

- 4 All Models will be contained in a display out of reach of bystanders behind tables with club members in attendance. At no time will any model, electric or otherwise be powered up during the display.
- 5 Simulators will be used to demonstrate model aircraft flight and operation.

Emergency or safety procedure:

- 6 A small first aid kit must be available while models are displayed.
- 7 If any fuel powered models are displayed, a suitable fire extinguisher must be present.
- 8 If there is personal injury to a member or spectator, Call 911, advise the person in charge for the Mall.
 - a. Western Development Museum Moose Jaw has everything needed to respond to any emergency situation. (defibrillator, fire extinguishers etc.)
- 9 There are no other risk mitigating strategies required at this site.
- 10 The Club executive will review these rules annually and prior to any additional display(s).
