Normal operating procedures and Site safety rules

- 1) There is no flying of model aircraft permitted at this event. This event will only permit static displays of inoperable models
- 2) All models on display will be unpowered without batteries (flight batteries, ignition batteries and/or propulsion batteries) installed. All fuel is to be removed from any fuel powered model.
- 3) Models are not allowed to be powered up or operated in any way at this display event.
- 4) The models will always be always out of reach of bystanders. FMAC club members will be in attendance at all times.
- 5) Only FMAC club members will be allowed inside the designated display area, and all model aircraft must stay within the designated display area during the event.
- 6) Only FMAC club members will be permitted to handle model aircraft at this event.

Emergency or safety procedures

- 1) A suitable fire extinguisher must be available within the designated display area.
- 2) A small first aid kit must be available while the model aircraft are displayed.
- 3) Emergency procedures and location of emergency equipment are posted in the building.
- 4) There are no other emergency procedures or risk mitigation strategies required at this site
- 5) These rules will be reviewed by the club annually or prior to the next display event at this site
