Community Group Showcase – static display and info booth

Conditions for use - All persons participating in the display must:

1. be MAAC members in good standing.
2. be members of the North Shore R/C Modelers Club, and
3. agree to follow the MAAC Safety code and all other site rules.

The Club's display will be limited to one 3'x 6' table in the open floor space of the hall, on the perimeter.

Additional display tables for other organizations will be positioned around the perimeter and centre of the hall space.

A copy of these rules must be present during the display, either in print or electronically (on a phone/device).

In the event of an emergency, phone (9-11 or number) and the civic address for first responder is:

120 Hillside Drive North, Elliot Lake.

Normal operating procedures and Site safety rules

This is a static display event only.

- 1 There is no flying permitted at this site. The Club will only permit the static displays of inoperable model airplanes.
- 2 All power systems (gas, glow or electric) must be rendered inoperable by removing batteries, ignition leads or otherwise ensuring the model cannot inflict harm to any persons. All fuel is to be removed from any fuel powered models.
- 3 Models on display will contain no fuel and no batteries of any kind.
- 4 No propellers or batteries are to be in/on RC aircraft while on static display during this event.
- 5 NO power up demos on electric RC Aircraft area allowed. All propellers and batteries of electric rc aircraft are to be removed!!
- 6 Models on display will be secured to prevent accidental movement.
- 7 The public will not be allowed to handle the models.
- 8 The public will have access only to the front of the table – only Club members and the Zone Director are allowed behind the table.

Emergency or safety procedures

- 9 A suitable fire extinguisher and small first aid kit must be available.
- 10 Site Emergency Procedures.
 - a. Club participants will familiarize themselves with the safety procedures – including emergency exit locations - posted in the hall.
 - b. In the event of an emergency call 911.
- 11 There are no other risk mitigating strategies required at this modelling site.
- 12 The Club executive will review these rules at least once a year.
