Third Wednesday of February, May and October depending on availability or as scheduled.

Conditions for use - All persons using this modelling site must:

- 1. be MAAC members in good standing.
- be members of the Kamloops Model Airplane Society, or an invited guest, and
- 3. agree to follow the MAAC Safety code and all other site rules.

A copy of these rules must be present during the display, either in print or electronically (on a phone/device).

Airplane models may be on display, but no batteries will be on site.

Normal operating procedures and Site safety rules

This site is for non modelling purposes (Meetings) only. Static displays of airplane models area allowed, but no batteries will be on site.

- 1. Models are only allowed as static displays, and if a model is present, the model shall be rendered inoperable.
- 2. Models on display will be unpowered, no batteries will be allowed on site.
- 3. Any complete aircraft must have the propeller(s) removed and have all fuel removed from the tanks. Propulsion batteries must be disconnected.
- 4. A suitable fire extinguisher must be available if models are displayed.

Emergency or safety procedures

- 5. Emergency procedures will be reviewed at the beginning of the meeting
 - a. Emergency procedures such as phone numbers, exit locations, emergency equipment location (defibrillator, fire extinguishers etc.) and other emergency services as deemed appropriate.
- 6. There are no other risk mitigating strategies required at this modelling site.
- 7. The Club will review these rules at least once a year.
