To operate the following categories of models: **mRAS and RPAS**

At or from the following location: **Summerland Flyers**, Bathville Road, 0.45 km past Rodeo Ground Entrance, within .5 nm of **49 34 51.2 N 119 44 16.8 W**

This authorization is contingent upon all members who use this site following the applicable Aviation Regulations, local laws, the club rules and the MAAC Safety Code.

MAAC provides the following:

- This site requires all RPAS pilots to meet Basic RPAS requirements for RPAS operations below 400'AGL.
- RPAS pilots intending to operate above 400'AGL must have a valid and current Advanced RPAS Operators certificate or be operating under an appropriate authority issued by MAAC or Transport Canada.
- This site has been approved for RPAS operations to a maximum altitude of **600'AGL**, provided all conditions outlined in the MAAC approved club rules and MAAC SFOC are met.
- While operating RPA above 400', the VO **shall or other nearby responsible person, shall** monitor the Princeton VFR Terminal Procedures frequency of 118.5 (Princeton Radio) for approaching transient VFR aircraft.
- CAR compliance remains an individual responsibility.
- Any changes to club rules or procedures upon which this authorization was issued **MUST** be approved by MAAC.

This authorization is valid until the SUMMERLAND FLYERS SOCIETY [Club 502, Zone C] fails to renew their MAAC membership, dissolves, or otherwise does not comply with any MAAC requirements or requests.
