



This certifies that MAAC has authorized **CENTRAL ALBERTA RADIO FUN FLYERS (RED DEER) [Club 37, Zone A]**

To operate the following categories of models: **mRPAS & RPAS**


At or from the following location: 7.5 KM E of Hwy 2 on Township Road 374 (ORCA), 26534 TWP ROAD 374, Red Deer County, AB – within 0.5 nm of 52° 12' 8.39"N, 113° 42' 18.48"W

This authorization is contingent upon all members who use this site following the applicable Canadian Aviation Regulations, local laws, Club and event rules as well as the MAAC Safety Code.

MAAC provides the following:

- This site requires all RPAS pilots to meet Basic RPAS requirements for RPAS operations below 400'AGL.
- RPAS pilots intending to operate above 400'AGL must have a valid and current Advanced RPAS operators certificate or be operating under an appropriate authority issued by MAAC or Transport Canada.
- This site has been approved for RPAS operations to a maximum of **900'AGL**, provided all conditions outlined in the approved club rules and MAAC SFOC are met.
- While operating RPA above 400', the VO, or other responsible nearby adults **shall monitor** full scale aviation communications on the established Red Deer Common Frequency Area (CFA) VHF frequency 122.875 mhz. The VO may also **concurrently** monitor the aerodrome traffic frequency (ATF) for CLB5 of 118.5mhz as deemed appropriate.
- CAR compliance remains an individual responsibility
- Any changes to club rules or procedures upon which this authorization was issued **MUST** be approved by MAAC.

This authorization is valid until the CENTRAL ALBERTA RADIO FUN FLYERS (RED DEER) [Club 37, Zone A] fails to renew their MAAC membership, dissolves, or otherwise does not comply with any MAAC requirements or requests.
