

Shuswap Lake Aero Modellers Mall Show Rules

*Shuswap Lake Aero Modellers have been given permission to conduct MAAC modelling activities indoors and fully understand and agree any permission granted applies to indoor activities **only** – no exceptions*

Purpose: Static model display inside the mall.

Conditions for use - All persons displaying models at this site must:

1. be MAAC members in good standing.
2. be members of the Shuswap Lake Aero Modellers Club, or an invited guest of: Shuswap Lake Aero Modellers
3. agree to follow the MAAC Safety code and all other site rules.

No RPAS will be started or powered up during this display

The static display will be set up in the center of the mall as to not impede with customer/bystander traffic. The mall maintenance personnel will set up the display tables and insure that all clearances around the display meet with the local fire marshall's rules and regulations.

There will be at least two Shuswap Lake Aero Modellers members on site at all times.

The public will be cordoned off from access to the static display by a roped off area around the display/

These rules will be posted at the display for the club members and public to observe.

Normal MAAC operating procedures and Site safety rules.

- 1 There is no flying permitted at this site. The Club will only permit the static displays of inoperable model airplanes.
- 2 All power systems (gas, glow or electric) must be rendered inoperable by removing batteries, ignition leads or otherwise ensuring the model cannot inflict harm to any persons.
- 3 All fuel is to be removed from any fuel powered models.
- 4 NO power up demos on electric RC Aircraft area allowed. All propellers and batteries of electric rc aircraft are to be removed!!
- 5 Charging of lithium batteries is not allowed at the static display. Batteries are not to be connected to the model.
- 6 All models to be displayed in such a way as to not interfere with emergency exiting of the building/site, models ideally be placed on display tables.

Emergency or safety procedures

- 7 A fire extinguisher must be available.
- 8 A small first aid kit must be available.
- 9 Site emergency procedures.
 - a. **In case of emergency, call 911**
- 10 There are no other risk mitigating strategies required at this site.
- 11 The Club/ Event organizer/executive will review and approve these rules prior to each event.
