NANAIMO MODEL- AIRS RULES

Administrative

To use the Nanaimo Model-Airs flying field, members must have a current MAAC membership as well as a Transport Canada basic or advanced pilot permit for Canadian Air Regulations (CAR) Part IX operations.

- · Each member must have paid their yearly club dues
- Each pilot must have their MAAC membership card in their possession and their RPAS permit number available.

Operating/Safety Rules

- 1. All flying must be done in accordance with CAR part IX and the current MAAC safety codes.
- 2. Electric or non-powered only, no gas/glow powered models.
- 3. Flying over the parking lot, building or road that borders the field is prohibited.
- 4. All flying should be conducted away from the take-off and landing path to the east of the field.
- 5. Line of Sight flying only.
- 6. No flying will be conducted if the field is in use by other persons conducting organized sports.
- 7. If maintenance persons are on or near the field, flying will only be conducted with their express permission.
- 8. Maximum flight altitude is 120m/400ft.
- 9. Batteries should not be connected unless the model is restrained in the pit area.
- 10. No taxiing to or from or in the pit area. Models should be carried to the takeoff area.
- 11. The direction of take-off and landing will be determined by the prevailing wind. In calm conditions, take-offs and landings should be from North to South.
- 12. No congregating at the flight line. Only the pilot and their spotter if required should be on the flight line.
- 13. Parked models should be kept away from the flight line.
- 14. Take-off and landing should be loudly announced by the pilot.
- 15. Recovery of aircraft away should be announced and done in agreement of all pilots flying.
- 16. While flying, pilots should stand at least 7m/20ft from the runway.
- 17. The approved flying area is indicated in Figure 1 below.
- 18. Safety first and common sense apply!
