Introduction to Scale Fly-Day

Purpose

To get people together who have a common interest in Scale Aero-Modelling and to support the national organizations.

Overview

Fun Scale Fly-Day promotes scale flying and building within the clubs' area. The design is a casual day at the field where scale interest people can show up and enjoy the day with those of common interest.

- Does not interfere with other open flying at the field.
- Consider introducing flyers to a scale flying routine.
- Opportunity for "Show and Tell" explaining scale programs
- Invite experienced scale flyers and judges to participate.

How to organize

All it takes is a club member requesting those interested in Scale to show up at the field with their scale airplanes.

Invite experienced scale judges/flyers to the event.

• From those attending there may be some trained judges who can introduce flight judging and static judging to those so inclined.

One flight station could be used for those who want to practise or try flying in front of judges.

- Scores would be kept confidential.
- Experienced Scale Flyers may show up to practise and provide assistance to the novice flyers.

Club Benefits:

- Promotes RC Aero-modelling in the club.
- Provides a club activity.
- Does not interfere with other flying.
- Allows judges and flyers practise time.
